Features of the house:

- Passive solar design
- Polished concrete floors
- Nutricycle System for recycling of human body products, garbage and gray water
- Timber structure
- Exterior Lime stucco, breathable
- Interior, unpainted plaster walls
- Radiant floors
- Active solar hot water
- Straw bale walls
- Reclaimed wood floors
- Reclaimed doors
- Green roof structure
- Ceiling fans (no air-conditioner)
- Whole house fan
- Sleeping porch
- Rain barrels

Directions: Immediately after or before the Rt. 15- Point of Rocks Bridge, on the Virginia side, take Lovettsville Rd to the north. Go five miles to Taylorstown road and take a left. Go one mile to the Ecovillage development and turn left onto Hickory Shade Lane- one mile to house.
